In the case of crawler or mobile cranes, where the tower crane attachment is mounted, the long boom provisions of this Agreement shall be computed from the boom pins on the rotation base to the point sheaves.

Note (B): It shall not be considered a condition of employment to maintain CCO certification, unless documentation is provided that the owner of the project specifies CCO certification.
