OFFICIAL RULES
LOCAL 139 I.U.O.E, AFL-CIO
POKER RUN and RAFFLES

Local 139 International Union of Operating Engineers is an unincorporated association exempt from taxation under federal and state laws. The Poker Run and Raffles are being conducted by Local 139 to raise money to make a charitable donation to Hogs for Heroes, Inc., a Section 501(c)(3) charity organization which supports Wisconsin Veterans. The event this year will be held on Saturday, June 27, 2026, with registration starting at 9:00 a.m., at Summit Ridge, N795 WI-58, Wonewoc, Wisconsin..

A. POKER RUN AND SWEEPSTAKES DRAWING

1. Registration Fees: The registration fee for a motorcycle rider, car/truck or UTV driver is \$25.00 and \$15.00 for each passenger. On the day of the event, the registration form and fee must be paid in order to enter the venue and/or participate in the ride. The Registration Fees help offset the costs of conducting the event, including payments for printing costs, venues, food and entertainment, etc., with any amounts above that needed to host the event being donated directly to Hogs for Heroes, Inc.

2. Poker Run: In order to participate in the riding portion of the Poker Run, an appropriate waiver must be signed by all motorcycle riders, UTV drivers, car/truck drivers and each of their passengers of the day of the event, prior to being granted entry. Motorcycles may have one passenger and UTV's or car/trucks may have additional passengers up to the vehicle's maximum seat belted seating arrangement. Additional waiver forms will be provided to list passengers in excess of three passengers. The final route and destinations will be provided to all registrants the morning of the event.

3. Free Poker Drawing/Sweepstakes: All registrants will receive a ticket on which they can collect stamps from the venues along the Poker Run. At the event finish point, a fully-stamped ticket can be exchanged for a drawing of five playing cards. Local 139 agents will verify and record the hand drawn by each Poker drawing entrant, which must be submitted by 4:00 p.m. The Local 139 agents' determination of who had the winning hands in the Poker drawing shall be final. The top three hands drawn, as verified and determined by the designated Local 139 agents, shall be awarded the following prizes:

1 st Prize	\$500.00
2 nd Prize	\$300.00
3 rd Prize	\$150.00

4. No person may enter the Poker sweepstakes drawing more than once. The Poker drawing will be held at the Local 139 Poker Run and/or dinner event on June 27, 2026 at Summit Ridge, N795 WI-58, Wonewoc, Wisconsin.. Eligible participants must be present to win a prize.

5. There is no purchase necessary to obtain a ticket, obtain stamps or exchange the ticket for playing cards to enter the Poker sweepstakes drawing. One free ticket will be provided on request from the designated Local 139 agents at the event.

B. RULES FOR RAFFLES

1. Multiple raffle tickets will be available for purchase at the event, including:

- a. a bucket raffle for several items donated by sponsors of the event
- b. a 50/50 raffle
- c. a Blackstone Griddle, 36” Omnivore Griddle, Laser Etched Logos on Hood

2. The purchase price for the bucket raffle is \$2.00 per ticket or 15 tickets for \$20.00. The purchase price for the 50/50 raffle is \$5.00 per ticket or 5 tickets for \$20.00. The price for the custom Local 139/Hogs for Heroes Blackstone Griddle raffle is \$10.00 per ticket. No part of the purchase price is deductible as a charitable contribution. If an entrant’s payment is not honored by the bank, the entry will be declared invalid, and the entrant shall not have a chance to win a prize.

3. All entries require purchase of tickets and shall be entitled to one entry per ticket purchased. Tickets must be purchased in person at the Local 139 Poker Run, directly from an agent or designee of Local 139 authorized to sell tickets. Eligible participants may purchase as many tickets as they like prior to the time of the drawing.

4. The drawing will be held at the Local 139 Poker Run and/or dinner event on June 27, 2026 at Summit Ridge, N795 WI-58, Wonewoc, Wisconsin.. Eligible participants must be present to win any raffle prize.

5. Only eligible participants in possession of the winning ticket shall be entitled to be awarded a prize. Any prize unclaimed after the “final call” of a winning ticket or claimed by a winner who is determined to be ineligible to be awarded a prize shall be forfeited, and an immediate additional drawing(s) will be held until the prize is awarded to an eligible winner.

6. Random drawings for the raffle items will be held until all prizes have been awarded. Before each drawing, an announcement shall be made stating the specific prize to be awarded for said drawing. Prizes may not be substituted.

C. ADDITIONAL RULES FOR POKER DRAWING AND RAFFLES

1. Winners shall be responsible for any and all federal, state and local taxes, fees assessments and like charges due in conjunction with acquiring a prize, if any. Winners are advised to consult his or her own tax professional to determine the extent of any such obligations.

2. Additionally, winners shall be responsible for any and all delivery, title, licensing and/or other fees related to the transfer of ownership and/or registration of any prize awarded.

3. Winners agree that they are receiving the awarded prize in “as is” condition and Local 139 makes no warranties and expressly disclaims any warranties included, but not limited to any expressed or implied warranties with respect to the condition, fitness and/or merchantability regarding any prize.

4. Local 139 shall have no obligation to deliver a prize to any winner. Winners shall be responsible for any and all costs associated with pick up, transportation and/or receipt of their prize.

5. A list of the sweepstakes drawing winners will be available at the Local 139 offices. By accepting a prize or prize voucher, winners agree to permit Local 139 to use his or her name and to take and use a photograph for promotional purposes. A copy of the list of sweepstakes drawing winners may be obtained by sending a self-

addressed, stamped envelope to: Local 139, Attn: Sweepstakes Information, N27W232 33 Roundy Drive, Pewaukee, Wisconsin 53072.

6. Entrants in the Poker sweepstakes drawing and/or raffles must be 18 years of age or older in order to claim a prize. All full-time employees of Local 139, its affiliated fringe benefit funds, and their immediate family members (residing in the same household) are not eligible to enter, participate, win or claim a prize with respect to the Poker sweepstakes drawing and/or raffles. Board members of Hogs for Heroes are also not eligible to enter, participate, win or claim a prize with respect to the Poker Sweepstakes drawing and/or raffles.

7. The odds of winning are determined by the number of entries.

8. The Poker sweepstakes drawing and raffles are subject to these Official Rules, which may not be changed by any oral or written statement by any employee or agent of Local 139.

9. All decisions of Local 139 shall be final on all matters. Participants agree that Local 139 shall have no obligation or liability to them except to award the prizes in the manner set forth in these Official Rules.

10. All proceeds, less costs and expenses, will be donated to Hogs for Heroes, Inc.
